- Only in the event of extreme high winds and heavy rain will we reschedule the event.
- No refund on ticket sales. All sales are final, unless the event is cancelled or rescheduled. Although we will do our best to keep you informed of any cancellation, it is the ticket holders' responsibility to establish whether an event has been cancelled and the date and time of any rearrange event.
- We are unable to accept any liability or replace any tickets lost, stolen or damaged after they have been received by you.
- The club accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to property or injury to persons whilst on the premises including the car park.
- Catering and licensed bar facilities will be available on-site throughout the event. No fires, barbecues or gazebos are permitted.
- Smoking or vaping is not permitted in the seating area, there will however be a designated 'Scorpion' smoking area.
